DCYF is committed to ensuring safety for staff and young people at GHS. We are engaging with partners and lawmakers on necessary steps to safely resume therapeutic rehabilitation and education services, and to expand capacity to serve a larger number of medium/maximum security young men. This weekly summary offers a snapshot of the current population at GHS, programming and safety updates, and related actions underway.
