### Child Care COVID-19 Grants

Providers who are open and currently providing care may apply to receive one-time funds. Funding amounts are based on licensed capacity:

Small (0-49)	Medium (50-99)	Large (100+)
\$6,500	\$11,500	\$14,000

Funds can be spent on facility/space rent, personnel, utilities, health and safety/cleaning supplies and food. An online application will be available in DCYF's licensed provider portal.




