Discussion	 There were no concerns with the proposed definition of an Indian Child Verification of Tribal Status: ECEAP & Early ECEAP Applicant Tribal Question: On the verification form where the parent signs, it says if they provide fraudulent information, they may have to pay back ECEAP funds. How do you determine that? DCYF Response: That is language that lives on current ECEAP application. It is there so that staff can ensure parents understand the weight of providing accurate information. Historically, DCYF has not requested funds back. It is not our practice. If someone provides false information on their form and it is discovered that they are not eligible, DCYF would stop providing that service. We work with ECEAP contractors to gather information and work with DCYF staff on how to support families. If it's determined that a family does not qualify then the services will end. If the situation arises part way through the year, we allow the child to continue services and then stop at the end of the year.
