- Mandatory Reporting/Mandatory Supporting: Continue to review other jurisdictions and follow workgroup at DCYF.
- Review implementation of new child welfare requirements through legislation and caselaw Family time, Relative Placement / parental preference, Active Efforts, ICWA cases.
- Continue to review DCYF contracting practices (supporting), recruitment and retention of providers. This work will be conducted via the CRP Contracts and Services Subcommittee and joint workgroup with DCYF.
- Continue focus to review data on infants / newborns coming into care because of SUD, outcomes, prefiling representation.
- Continue to Review DCYF policies, practice, and data related to Educational Stability for children in out of home care.
