Slot Payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CA shall pay the Contractor a flat slot payment for IFPS-HOMEBUILDERS® services, based on CA authorized team capacity. • Therapists are expected and able to carry 2 cases at a time and serve an average of 18 cases in a year (an average of 9 case minimum for half-time therapists), and provide up to two booster sessions totaling an average of 5 hours per case to former client families, as appropriate. • Therapist must be on staff during the month of payment for the Contractor to receive the monthly payment. • Supervisors are expected to carry 6 cases their first year as a HOMEBUILDERS® supervisor and have 40 hours of direct client contact in subsequent years. • Slot payment shall be billed monthly by the Contractor on an A-19 billing invoice and send to: <div style="text-align: center;"> <u>HQ IFPS Program Manager:</u> Children's Administration PO Box 45710 Olympia, WA 98504-5710 </div> 	<p>\$4,397.00 per full-time therapist each month</p> <p>\$2,198.00 per half-time therapists</p> <p>\$1,466.00 per supervisor each month</p>

	Completed Intervention	Family engaged in and completed the intervention.	\$2,996
	Partial Under 10	For cases where less than 10 hours of direct counseling time was provided to the family.	\$489
	Partial Over 10	For cases where more than 10 hours of direct counseling time was provided to the family but the service was not completed.	\$1,531
Case Related Travel	DSHS shall pay the Contractor for actual case related travel. Case related travel shall only include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travel to and from the family's home to provide services; • The Contractor shall adhere to the following travel time stipulations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrange visits in the family home to limit travel time; • Allowable travel time is portal to portal. CA will use Google Maps to evaluate reasonableness of claimed time; • Travel time shall be calculated as the distance from the counselor's workplace (location where the counselor normally performs his/her work) or previous client appointment; 		\$22.41 per hour

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No reimbursement for travel shall be paid for travel between counselor’s residence and office; and • Travel time shall be reasonable. <p>Current state rate on date service delivered. Current rates for travel can be accessed at: http://ofm.wa.gov/policy/10.90a.pdf</p> <p>Any travel beyond 50 miles to the appointment or returning (i.e. one-way) must be authorized by the Regional Program Manager.</p> <p>Case Related Travel cannot be claimed when Rural Supplement is claimed on a case.</p>	
Rural Supplement	<p>The Contractor shall serve families within the contracted catchment area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Contractor shall strive to assign therapists who are closest geographically to the client family. Therapists are expected to live within two (2) hours of the families the Contractor serves. • Therapist travel time shall not exceed two (2) hours. • If therapist lives over one (1) hour from the client family, the therapist shall discuss the travel timeframes with the CA gatekeeper and/or social worker prior to accepting the referral. <p>A rural supplement payment to the Contractor <i>may</i> be authorized to support services to families who live more than one (1) hour and less than two (2) hours away from the therapist or the Contractor’s office, whichever is closer to the family. If approved by the CA regional program lead, this one-time payment per family <i>may</i> be paid at case closure.</p>	\$1,000
Service Duration	Services typically may last between 30 and 45 days.	
Concrete Goods	<p>Up to \$200 may be requested by the provider to support reunification or placement prevention and must be authorized in advance by the assigned CA staff.</p> <p>The CA Concrete Goods Guide may be found here: https://www.dshs.wa.gov/sites/default/files/CA/pub/documents/0514ConcreteGoodsGuide.pdf</p>	<p>An average of \$200 per family</p> <p>Up to \$30.00 of the total may be used for engagement and does not need prior CA approval.</p>
