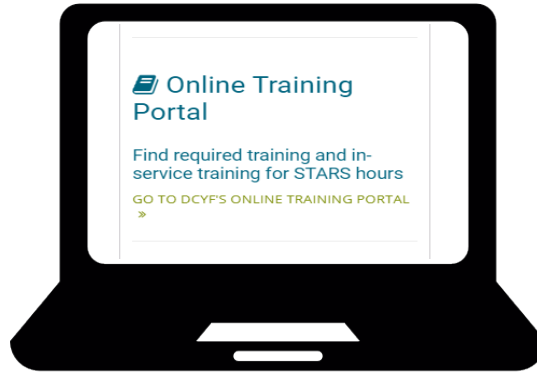


- **Providers** will find, access and complete trainings.

- **Trainer Applicants** will apply to become State-Approved Trainers.

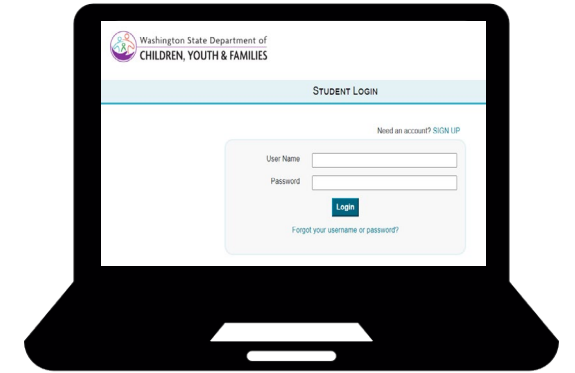

- First external announcements to all child care providers

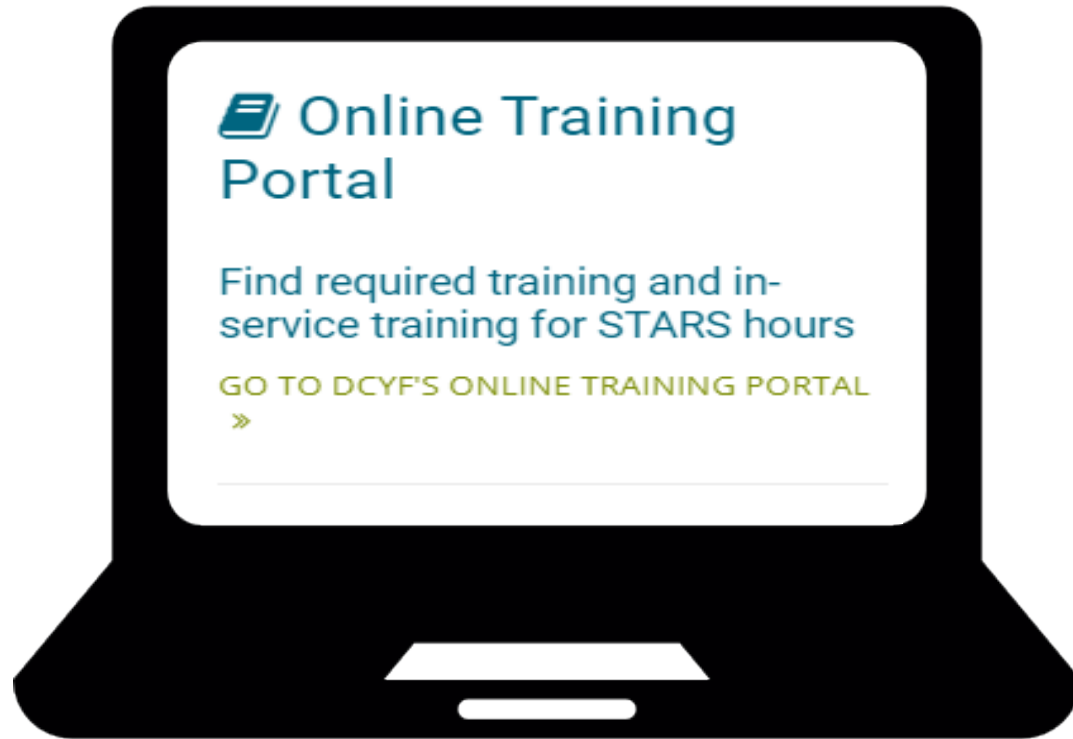
- User Testing: State Trainers and Training Orgs

- Planning/creation for resources/materials for transition

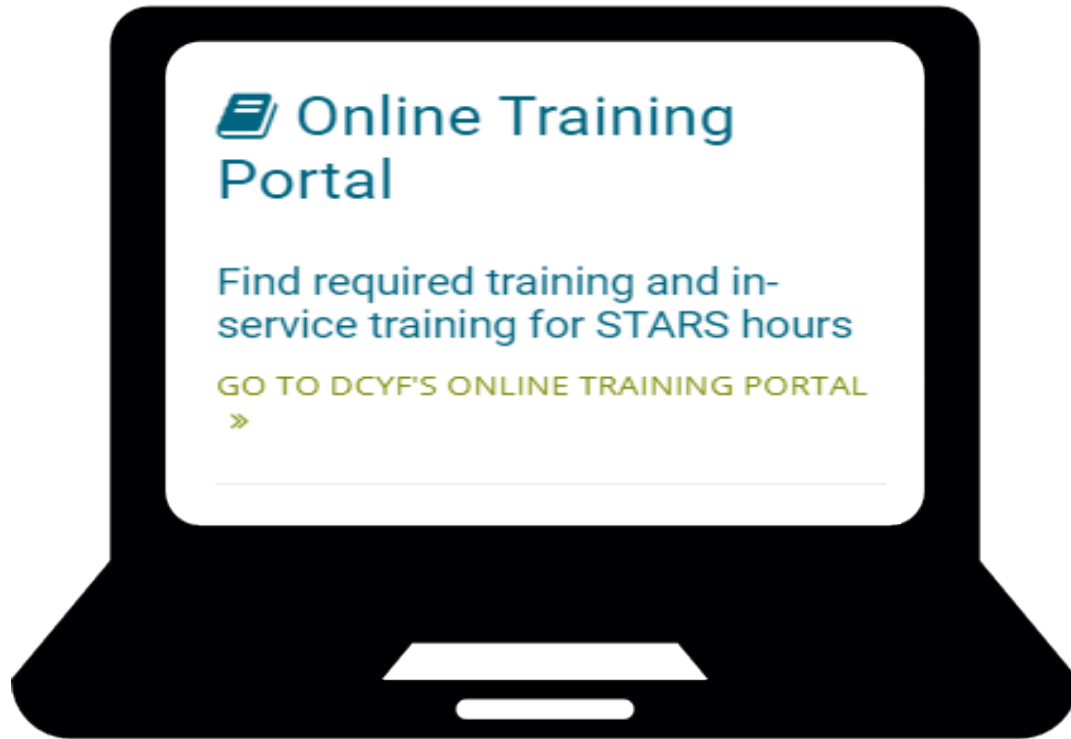
- Trainers and Training Orgs get access to DEVELOP
