

MIECHV Measure: Primary Caregiver Education



Home visitors can support families' economic self-sufficiency by helping caregivers obtain additional education ([MIHOPE Impact Study Report, 2019](#)).

Measure: Percent of primary caregivers who enrolled in home visiting without a high school degree or equivalent, who subsequently enrolled in or maintained continuous enrollment in middle school or high school, or completed high school or equivalent during their participation in home visiting

What to collect:	Education status of primary caregiver, including all education completed and current status as a student
For whom:	Primary caregivers in MIECHV-funded programs who enrolled without a high school degree or equivalent
When to ask:	At minimum annually.

Note:

Education data should be collected at least annually. Whenever the primary caregiver discusses a change in their education, update their response in your data system.

Once a primary caregiver who enrolled without a high school diploma or GED subsequently enrolls in, maintains continuous enrollment in, or completes high school or a GED, they have met the measure and will not be included in future years.

Measure Production Details

Calculate: Percent who completed or maintained school enrollment among those who enrolled in home visiting without a high school diploma or GED.

Numerator	Number of primary caregivers who enrolled in or maintained continuous enrollment in middle school or high school, or completed a high school degree or equivalent after enrollment in home visiting (and met the conditions specified in the denominator)
Denominator	Number of primary caregivers without a high school degree or equivalent at enrollment
Missing	Educational attainment missing at enrollment or annual education status missing for caregiver without a high school diploma or GED at enrollment

Required Data Elements:

- Highest level of education at time of enrollment
- Current highest level of education
- Current educational status (enrolled in school or not)
