## 2024-2025 Areas of Focus

The PIFS CRP is dedicated to ensuring a safe environment where quality deliberations take place by allowing every individual the opportunity to be heard without censorship or judgement. The following areas of focus will be monitored during FY 2024-2025.

- Follow existing implementation of legislation for review of its impact to policy and practice at DCYF. The PIFS CRP will follow proposed legislation.
- Continue SUD, POSC, Housing Review
- Data transparency on child abuse and neglect allegations.
- CSEC policy and practice at DCYF.
- Forensic interviewing during investigations and the impact of training and MDT.
- DCYF MH policy, stabilization of youth and families in-home. Review CBOs and services that meet needs of families with significant MH and behavioral needs.
- Safety Plans
