

Model Proxy

• DCYF uses this model to understand the costs involved in having one FTE of the main service delivery person

- Cost Factors
 - Service Delivery standards/ Workload Standard
 - Personnel
 - Quality and Training
 - Overhead and Operational Costs

- Example ABC program
 - ABC Service Worker Higher Standard and qualification → lower caseload ratio
 - Navigator and Peer Support Lower standard and qualification → Higher caseload ratio
- HV PAT Program
 - Use contract & Model standards to create reference table for PAT
 - Opportunity for provider to ask question and provide feedback
