- Year 1 funding
 - o January-June, June-October (DCYF fiscal year overlap)
 - o Focus on facilitation contractor
 - o Continuing to build community networks
 - o Bring together community input and data (with DCYF partnership)
 - o Output: Community Prevention Plan
 - o Long term commitment: network coordinator
 - Future subcontractors (?)
- What else to include in facilitation contract?
- Future consideration: Who might be well suited to this work?
- Questions/thoughts:
 - o Can we more clearly define - what is meant by “community prevention plan”?
 - This specific grant - keeping families from moving to child welfare system and foster care, who are already having a lot of challenges in their lives
 - Looking at a balance of risk and protective factors - use risk and protective factor language for RFP
 - o Need to look at research on who gets involved in child welfare - look closely to determine what kinds of programs will be effective
 - o Looking at risk factors and protective capacities - what is specific to this county - what risk factors have not rising to the level of a FAR case
