Summary of Parent Pay

Costs of support, treatment, and confinement -- Order -- Contempt of court.

The applicable law is RCW 13.40.220

WAC is: 388-720;

In the WAC is a schedule (below) used to determine the degree of financial obligation to repay the Department for a youth's care and custody.

Parents/others are exempt from the obligation if:

- The victim of the youth's crime lives in the home;
- The parent/obligated person receives or is qualified to receive an adoption allowance or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF);
- The household income lies under 150% of the Federal Poverty Guideline, (Federal Poverty "Level").

PAYMENT OBLIGATION

- Parents must submit a Financial Information Statement (FIS) to the Office of Financial Recovery (OFR), otherwise they are assessed the full cost of care.
- OFR uses the FIS and other information to assess the obligation amount, which can range from zero up to 20% of gross household income.
- Assessment is calculated according to the schedule and can never be for more than the actual cost of care.
- Payments can be spread over a term when negotiated with OFR.
- There is an appeal process.
