TRIBAL EARLY LEARNING FUND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

Funding Opportunity General Information

Question: Will the dollars applied for by 03/01/2024 need to be spent by 06/30/2024?

Answer: Yes, the funds will need to be spent down by the end of the fiscal year. The fiscal year, 07/01/2023 through 06/30/2024.

Question: Will we need to reapply again around 07/01/2024?

Answer: Yes, you will need to reapply for the fiscal year 2024-2025. The Request for Funding date has not been determined but we are working on getting it out before July 1, 2024.

Question: Do we only count the children that are birth through 5 years of age?

Answer: Yes, the TELF grant provides funding from prenatal to age 5.

Question: Ok, to clarify school age child care is not allowable?

Answer: Correct. We wish we could serve all tribal children the TELF Grant is intended for prenatal to age 5.

Question: If all our children under 5 are not tribal, do we not count them in for funding activities?

Answer: If your program does not serve prenatal women or tribal children, age 5 and under, you do not qualify for funding. If your program serves tribal children, or prenatal women, you qualify. Please apply.

Question: With the anticipation of RFA release early next year, can funds be carried over into the next fiscal year OR do they need to be spent by June 30, 2024?

Answer: No, funds from fiscal year 2023-2024 cannot be carried over. Funds need to be spent by June 30, 2024.

Question: Can the funding award be through June 30, 2025?

Answer: Funding needs to be spent the fiscal year you applied for. So, funding from fiscal year 2024-2025 can be spent up to June 30, 2025.

Question: Can applicants apply in both fiscal years?

Answer: Yes! We strongly encourage applicants to apply in both fiscal years. Please apply twice.

Question: Do I need to have separate applications for more than one priority?

Answer: No, you can select multiple priorities in the drop-down list on the smartsheet application. The smartsheet application is located here:

Question: Is the TELF funding one time funding or annual?

Answer: As of right now this is a one-time funding, for two separate fiscal years, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025.

Question: Do I need to submit a separate budget and justification?

Answer: Yes. At this time, please email the documents directly to rayna.espinosa@dcyf.wa.gov. In the near future, we hope to add an upload option on the smartsmart application. Question: Can you give me an example of 3.5.1. Cost itemization by priority and expense?

Answer: See examples below.

Priority 1: Tribal Language Education A Lushootseed speaker/teacher-\$30,000

Priority 2: Elder Storytelling Storytelling - \$30,000

Priority 6: Traditional Music & Arts Arts, and Music - \$20,000

Question: Can we backdate our invoices for services as aligned with the TELF priorities to the beginning of the fiscal year, July 1, 2023?

Answer: Yes, you can back date your invoice to July 1, 2023. As the goods and services are within 2023-2024 fiscal year *and* align with the TELF priorities.

Question: If we are not tribally licensed or certified/certified for payment only, but will be in the near future, can we still apply for this fiscal year 2023-2024?

Answer: No. The TELF grant currently requires that you are currently serving tribal children. Please stay tuned for the next round of TELF for fiscal year 2024-2025 as we anticipate eligibility updates.
