

List of Aligned Curricula

This list provides guidance and information for learning professionals to select highquality, evidence-based curricula that reflect the strengths and needs of children, families, educators and communities.

About the List of Aligned Curricula

In June 2017, the University of Washington published a Curriculum Consumer Report to identify evidence-based curricula that align with the Washington State Early Learning and Development Guidelines. That report is a list of curricula that meet the curricular alignment standard in Early Achievers.

How to Use this List

Each curricula listed are considered "comprehensive" because they include learning goals and activities across multiple domains, including literacy, mathematics, and social/emotional development. The curricula list is divided according to age group. If you serve multiple age groups, you must use an aligned curriculum <u>or</u> complete the Curricular Alignment Tool (CAT) for each age group.

Example: If you serve children age birth to five, but only use an aligned curriculum designed for preschoolers, it will still be necessary to complete the Curricular Alignment Tool (CAT) for the curriculum you are using with infants and toddlers.

For Family Child Care:

You may use the Creative Curriculum for Family Child Care (which addresses infant, toddler, and preschool age groups), or, you may use both an Infant and Toddler Age curriculum **and** a Preschool Age curriculum to address the age groups in your care.
