



 - Specific focus on restitution and victims





Restitution victim data


- Free text format difficult to code and analyze

- Short-term solution: coding and analyzing a small sample of restitution victims in juvenile court cases






Felony offenses tended to have higher restitution amounts imposed. Average amount of restitution imposed \$4,000 \$3,000 \$2,000 \$1,000 Auto Theft/Vehicle Prowl, Fel Burglary, Except 1st Degree \$4,000 \$3,000 \$1,000 \$0 Theft/Fraud/Larceny, Fel \$4,000 \$3,000 \$2,000 \$1,000-- Average imposed - Higher imposed - Lower imposed
