Harbor Heights is in Grays Harbor County and can hold up to 46 young men. Harbor Heights is designed to provide a therapeutic space for those at the facility.

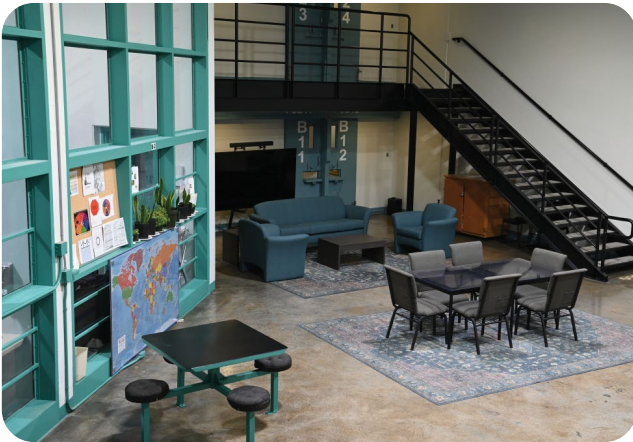


Young people at Harbor Heights will learn leadership skills and have an opportunity to earn peer mentorship certification. Young people in this program will participate for a minimum of six months and then transition to another facility or the community.

This program will be available to young people who meet the requirements and are committed to becoming leaders.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Over the age of 18
- Reached medium security level



Young people at Harbor Heights will benefit from:

- A living space with TVs in all rooms.
- Expanded visitation opportunities.
- Tablets and VR headsets for education.
- Tablets for family connections with email, text and video messaging (*coming soon*).
- A structured schedule.
- Career and vocational training.
- An innovative cognitive behavioral therapy program.
- Leadership programs and opportunities.

Harbor Heights will provide a safe, structured, and supportive space where young people can learn skills and develop positive habits that can be used to make a positive impact on their futures.
