Your DCYF team wants to partner with you to make sure that your voice is heard and shared with a caregiver that fits your needs.

# Here's What's Next

#### Reviewing Referral Information and Adding Your Voice

- You can choose to review your referral that is shared with potential caregivers.
- If you don't like what's in the referral, you can respond in the way that you are comfortable with completing.
- You will also be able to share additional information with potential caregivers i.e. creating a Q&A, filling out an "All About Me" form, drawing pictures, writing a note or letter, etc.



## Pre-Placement Contact and Maintaining Connections

- You will have a chance to connect with a potential caregiver before moving i.e. phone, video, or inperson visits.
- Do you have people in your life that are important to maintain a connection with? Give us all the information you have, and we will do all that we can for you to keep that relationship.
