## POL 10.3.2 MANAGING CHILD CARE SAFETY PLANS

This policy applies to DCYF managing safety plans.

- 1. DCYF May Issue Time Limited Safety Plans That Address A Serious Licensing Concern
- 2. A Safety Plan Must Not Be Used In Place of Enforcement Actions
- 3. A Safety Plan May Be Used Alone Or In Addition To An Inspection Report, A Facility Licensing Compliance Agreement Or An Enforcement Action
- 4. A Safety Plan Will Be Developed With The Early Learning or School-Age Provider, Licensor and Supervisor
- 5. Safety Plans Expire 30 Days After Being Signed By All Parties

A supervisor may only approve one 30 day extension as requested.

- 6. DCYF May Modify Or Remove Safety Plans At Any Time
- 7. DCYF May Take Enforcement Action When A Safety Plan Is In Place
