## POL 10.6.15 MANAGING CHILD CARE PROVIDER SELF-REPORTING INJURIES AND INCIDENTS

This policy applies when an early learning or school-age provider reports potential violations to DCYF child care licensing staff.

1. DCYF Will Direct Providers To Self-Report Injuries and Incidents Per WAC 110-300-0475 and WAC 110-301-0475

DCYF staff will not require providers to report injuries and incidents not listed in these WAC.

- 2. DCYF Staff Will Refer To DCYF 15-872 Child Care Provider Self-Reporting Matrix (Internal Use Only) When Determining How To Proceed After Being Made Aware Of Any Provider Self-Reported Injury or Incident
- 3. DCYF Licensors Must Notify Supervisors Of Self-Reports That Include Obvious WAC Violation(s) Or Suspected Child Abuse Or Neglect
