SUBJECT: CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT (RCW 34.05.325)

For rules proposed under notice filed as WSR 22-22-099 on November 2, 2022:

Amended WAC 110-15-0210

REASON FOR ADOPTION: Amendments to WAC 110-15-0210 implement Chapter 199 § 305 Laws of 2021 by establishing a dual language designation and providing for subsidy rate enhancements or site-specific grants for licensed or certified child care providers and ECEAP or Birth-to-Three ECEAP contractors who are given the dual language designation.

CHANGES MADE SINCE THE RULE WAS PROPOSED: None.

DCYF received these comments in support of the proposals:

I'm writing to express my support for a dual language designation and an associated subsidy rate enhancement. We put a lot of effort and financial resources into serving dual language learners, and a subsidy rate enhancement would be very helpful to continue serving these children and families.
